Led by Carinthia University of Applied Sciences (FH Kärnten), R3GIS, and the University of Udine, it integrates **science**, **technology**, and **community involvement** to make cities more nature-friendly.









BioBox: from research to action

The BioBox offers a cost-effective, easy-to-implement **toolkit of measures designed** to enhance biodiversity and ecosystem health, focusing on **birds**, **bats** and **pollinators**. Each action is grounded in real data and tailored to local ecosystems.

Implementation & Monitoring

The feasibility of the BioBox will be tested at pilot sites in Austria and Italy, and sensors will be used to assess the measures' effectiveness in improving biodiversity.

Knowledge and results are shared online and through workshops to **promote broader adoption**. Municipalities, citizens, and schools will be engaged through **awareness-raising campaigns** on the importance of biodiversity conservation.
