BioBox: from research to action

The BioBox offers a cost-effective, easy-to-implement **toolkit of measures designed** to enhance biodiversity and ecosystem health, focusing on **birds, bats** and **pollinators**. Each action is grounded in real data and tailored to local ecosystems.

Implementation & Monitoring

The feasibility of the BioBox will be tested at **pilot sites in Austria and Italy**, and **sensors** will be used to assess the measures' effectiveness in improving biodiversity.

Knowledge and results are shared online and through workshops to **promote broader adoption**. Municipalities, citizens, and schools will be engaged through **awareness-raising campaigns** on the importance of biodiversity conservation.
